

Toileting/changing Policy

In order to comply with Child Protection Procedures, we at Bellaghy Primary School exercise good practice in the toileting of children.

Staff must report to another member of staff before taking a child to the toilet.

Staff will respect the child's privacy and cultural beliefs at all times and will encourage independence and good hygiene.

Any abnormalities or concerns will be reported to the Principal.

A child's clothes will only be changed if they;

- become wet playing with water/messy play
- have a toilet accident
- are sick
- are in unsuitable clothing – e.g. too hot/cold

The staff will notify you in person or via a written note as to why your child has been changed.

The school has a small selection of spare clothing, which will be used in these events, and we ask you to return these promptly.

If you for any reason do not want your child changed in the event of any of the above, please inform the Principal in writing of your wishes.
